## PERMITS NEEDED FOR CARIBOU RECOVERY WORK

For wildlife capture and handling, rehabilitation, possession for scientific or educational purposes, or for treatments to enhance wildlife habitat, a permit is required.

Special Use Permit – Forestry

- Non-exclusive authority to a company or an individual to occupy and use an area of Crown land within the Provincial Forest
- Wildlife habitat enhancement treatments including associated facilities and camps (includes restoration if related to wildlife habitat)
- NOTE: Where a special use permit is not the appropriate form of authority of occupation, or the area is outside of a Provincial Forest, an authority to occupy is required under the <u>Land Act</u> which may be obtained through <u>FrontCounterBC</u>.

- Road a permit is required if you need to build a road
